Snow Removal Season – here's how to help

As we head into winter, a few reminders on snow removal operations... Please don't block walkways with cars, and remember to move cars after snowfall to help staff with snow removal. Vehicles must not block access to snow dump areas.

And of utmost importance, please keep children off the snow dump areas while any snow removal operations are active, and not just working that specific pile. Never let kids tunnel into these piles or snow banks either. The loader operator can't see the back sides of the piles, and the last thing we would want is for a child to be hurt during snow removal by being somewhere they shouldn't.

Dues Increase for 2017

Dues for 2017 will be increased from \$2,400 per quarter to \$2,500 per quarter. The primary driver requiring the increase is increased labor costs in the Tahoe area. As labor is a large percentage of our budget, we needed to increase dues in order to cover our corresponding increase in operating costs.

Dumpster Capacity Reduced



As previously reported, we have both smaller and fewer dumpsters available. This change was forced upon us by the garbage company. Most of the time capacity is adequate, but it may be tight during popular holidays. Please keep this in mind and be sure to minimize your volume – break down boxes, compact trash if possible, do not dispose of bulky items during holidays, and use the dumpster space efficiently.

Bears and Dumpsters (and cars!)

Speaking of dumpsters, don't forget that bears are always present at Rocky Ridge. Several have discovered that they can get a paw in if the lid is not fastened securely enough. Please use chains to securely fasten the lids so that the opening is minimized.

A reminder from the previous Newsletter - per the revised Davis-Sterling act, we are required to adopt and notify homeowners of a location where the board may post "General Notifications" from time to time.

- Physically on the bulletin board at the entry gate.

General reminders

- Bears though we haven't had major problems this year, bears are constantly around and come through every night. Maintain vigilance and keep latching the dumpsters. And keep food out of your car!
- Alterations If you are planning to do any remodeling or work on your unit, any structural change or any change to the exterior, no matter how minor, must be submitted for approval by the Board of Directors.

Updates on the property

- This year's furnace inspections are complete. The association covers cost of the inspection which includes a filter change. Anything requiring repair will be the responsibility of the homeowner.
- Deck upgrades are still proceeding as decks come due for major maintenance.
- Paver upgrades are still proceeding as sidewalks and entry ways come due for maintenance.
